- 1 TEAM A IS LEADING 48-0 WITH SEVEN MINUTES TO GO IN THE GAME. THERE IS A FIGHT THAT LEADS TO MULTIPLE EJECTION'S FOR BOTH TEAMS. AFTER THE EJECTION'S TEAM A HAS SIX PLAYERS LEFT AND TEAM B HAS EIGHT PLAYERS LEFT. THE REFEREE FORFEITS THE GAME AND THE FINAL SCORE IS TEAM B 1 AND TEAM A 0.
- 2 THE OFFICIAL' S JURISDICTION BEGINS WHEN THEY ARRIVE AT GAME SITE?
- 3 TEAM BOXES RUN FROM THE 25 YARD LINE TO THE 25 YARD LINE AND EXTEND FROM THE SIDELINE BACK AS FAR AS THE FIELD PERMITS?
- 4 PYLON CAN BE RED, ORANGE, YELLOW OR WHITE IN COLOR?
- 5 ON A CORRECTLY MARKED FIELD NO PYLONS ARE INBOUNDS?
- 6 THE GOAL IS A LINE ON THE FIELD THE SEPARATES THE FIELD OF PLAY FROM THE END ZONE?
- 7 THE FIELD OF PLAY INCLUDED ALL PARTS OF THE PLAYING FIELD THAT IS INBOUNDS, OTHER THAN THE END ZONES?
- 8 A LEGAL GAME BALL IS TO BE PROVIDED BY EACH TEAM?
- 9 IT IS LEGAL FOR A KICKING TEE TO ELEVATE THE BALL 1" OFF THE GROUND?
- 10 ANY QUESTIONS REGARDING THE LEGALITY OF PLAYER EQUIPMENT IS TO BE RULED ON BY THE REFEREE AND THE UMPIRE?
- 11 IT IS NOT LEGAL FOR TEAMS TO USE A VIDEO RECORDING OF THE FIRST HALF FOR COACHING PURPOSES AT THE HALFTIME INTERMISSION?
- 12 IT IS NOT LEGAL FOR TEAMS TO USE A VOICE RECORDING OF THE FIRST HALF FOR COACHING PURPOSES AT THE HALFTIME INTERMISSION?
- 13 FOR A GAME BALL TO BE LEGAL IT MUST HAVE BETWEEN 8 AND 12 EVENLY SPACED LACES?
- 14 It is legal for lineman A1 who is outside the free blocking zone to block B1 from behind prior to the ball leaving the free blocking zone?
- 15 A catch of an opponents pass or fumble is considered an interception?
- 16 To complete a catch, Airborne A1 must have possession of the ball and come down with both feet inbounds, unless contact by B1 causes him to come down out of bounds?
- 17 A catch is the act of establishing player possession of a live ball in flight?
- 18 A simultaneous catch or recovery is joint possession of a live ball by opposing players while one or both are in bounds?
- 19 The expanded neutral may expand into the end zone?
- 20 Initial force may result from a pass,kick, snap,fumble, carry or muff?
- 21 A new force may be given to a grounded backward pass?

- 22 A new force may be given to a grounded kick?
- 23 A new force may result from a legal or illegal act?
- 24 When a team commits two fouls during a down, it is a double foul?
- 25 A team member who is entering to fill a player vacancy who is on the opponent's side of the neutral zone when the ball is snapped is guilty of illegal substitution if during the down he touches the ball?
- 26 Following a scrimmage kick by K. The loose ball play ends when R1 touches the ball?
- 27 The spot where the run ends and where the ball becomes dead are always the same?
- 28 When an Airborne player makes a catch, forward progress is the foremost point of the ball if the player is contacted by a defender?
- 29 Blocking is obstructing an opponent with any part of the blockers body?
- 30 Illegal participation can be a nonplayer foul?
- 31 On kicks entering R's end zone force can be a determining factor on whether it is a safety or touchback?
- 32 On kicks entering K's end zone force can be a determining factor on whether it is a safety or touchback?
- 33 If touching the ball causes the ball to become dead, catching or recovering the ball has no significance?
- 34 No foul causes a live ball to become dead?
- 35 A player that is attempting to pass is considered a runner until he throws a legal forward pass?
- 36 A kicker continues to be a kicker until the kick ends?
- 37 When a runner is touching inbounds and the ball is outside the sideline. It is a touchdown if the ball breaks the plane of the goal line extended?
- 38 If A1 is guilty of a holding foul and after A2 is downed, A3 piles on, this is a multiple foul?
- 39 If substitute B1 is on A's side of the neutral when the ball is snapped, it is an encroachment foul?
- 40 The conference at the team huddle in between the hash marks is limited to 11 players?
- 41 The conference at the team sideline is limited to 11 players?
- 42 ALL unsportsmanlike fouls are enforced from the succeeding spot?
- 43 A snap is considered to be a backward pass and part of a loose ball play?
- 44 When the ball is loose following an illegal kick, it is treated as a fumble?
- 45 Any player that is in the free blocking zone at the snap may block below the waist?
- 46 A down begins when the ball is marked ready for play?
- 47 A fair catch signal given by a receiver in his own end zone is a foul?
- 48 An illegal shift is a dead ball foul?
- 49 A player loses possession by a fumble or a muff?

- 50 A nonplayer foul may or may not influence the play in progress?
- 51 If holder A1 muffs the snap and kicker A2 kicks the ball as A1 is attempting to secure possession, it is a good field goal if the kicked ball goes across the cross bar and between the uprights?
- 52 After the ball has been out of bounds, the clock will always start on the snap?
- 53 The clock shall be stopped when an illegal forward pass is incomplete?
- 54 If during the last timed down of a period A1 commits pass interference and the penalty is accepted, the period is automatically extended for an untimed down?
- 55 The period must be extended if during the last timed down of a period there was an inadvertent whistle?
- 56 The period must be extended if there is a dead ball foul following the last timed down of a period?
- 57 The clock will start with the snap on a scrimmage down following a fair catch?
- 58 The coach is allowed to use only one of the two types of conference during the game?
- 59 A Coach/Referees conference for review the possible misapplication of a rule is always an officials time out?
- 60 K2 IS DETECTED HOLDING AN OPPONENT BEFORE K1 PUNTS. R1 SIGNALS FOR AND MAKES A VALID FAIR CATCH. THE PENALTY BY K2 IS ACCEPTED. RULING: THE CLOCK SHALL START ON THE READY SIGNAL FOLLOWING ENFORCEMENT.
- 61 3 rd. AND 20 FROM K'S 20 YARD LINE. K1'S QUICK KICK IS BLOCKED BY R2 AND THE BALL IS RECOVERED BY K3 ON K'S 12 YARD LINE AND K3 IS TACKLED IMMEDIATELY. RULING: THE CLOCK WILL START ON THE READY FOR PLAY SIGNAL FOR THE NEXT DOWN.
- 62 FOLLOWING AN INCOMPLETE PASS ON 2 ND. DOWN, QB, A1 THROWS A LEGAL FORWARD PASS, ON 3RD. DOWN, TO A8 WHO IS 15 YARDS DOWNFIELD. DURING THE PASS AN OFFICIAL INADVERTENTLY BLOWS HIS WHISTLE. RULING: THE CLOCK WILL START WITH THE READY FOR PLAY WHEN THE DOWN IS REPLAYED.
- 63 4 th. And 5 for team A from A's 30. The game clock is running with 5 minutes remaining in the 3 rd. quarter. With team A in a scrimmage kick formation, the 25 second clock expires and the referee flags team A for delay of the game. Team B wants to decline the penalty. RULING: Team B may decline the penalty and the clock will start with the ready.
- 64 B1 recovers A6's fumble, however during B1's ensuing run, he fumbles the ball back to A11 who is immediately tackled and is downed. RULING: The clock starts with the snap due to the change of team possession.
- 65 An officials' timeout is granted due to an injury to B1. During the timeout, Team A players go near the sideline to confer with their head coach. RULING: Illegal conference.
- 66 The ball becomes dead when placekick holder K1 fumbles the snap, and after having his knee off the ground to recover, returns his knee to the ground while placing the ball?

- 67 The ball is dead and the down is ended when the kicker catch or recover any free kick anywhere?
- 68 The ball is dead and the down is ended when the kicker catch or recover any scrimmage kick anywhere?
- 69 R1 gives an invalid fair catch signal. R2 catches the ball. Ruling : The ball is dead immediately?
- 70 Any foul which occurs after an inadvertent whistle is sounded is a dead ball foul?
- 71 On the last timed down of the third period, A1 runs for a 15 yard gain where he is hit by B1. The helmet comes completely off of B1 and the covering official sounds his whistle. Ruling: Team A may accept the results of the play and the period is automatically extended for an untimed down.
- 72 K1 punts the ball on 4 th down. The ball rolls to a stop on R's 5 yard line. K1 touches the ball at the five and it is then picked up and advanced to the 25 by R2. Ruling: Legal play.
- 73 Place kick holder K1 rises to catch a bad snap. He immediately returns his knee to the ground. Ruling: Legal
- 74 Place kick holder K1 muffs a bad snap. He rises to recover the loose ball and immediately returns his knee to the ground. Ruling: Legal
- 75 Snapper K1 makes a bad snap that is rolling on the ground. Place kick holder K2 recovers the snap without ever taking his knee off the ground. Ruling: Legal
- 76 Snapper K1 makes a bad snap that is rolling on the ground. Place kick holder K2 recovers the snap after taking his knee off the ground. Place kick holder K2 immediately returns his knee to the ground and places the ball for a kick. Ruling: Legal
- 77 In overtime, A1 goes back to pass and is hit by B1. A1 fumbles and the loose ball is picked up by B2 who runs for a touchdown? The overtime is over as Team B scored?
- 78 It is impossible for A1 to fumble in B's end zone as the ball became dead via the touchdown?
- 79 Team A cannot gain a first down if during the down team A fouls and the penalty is accepted?
- 80 If a third down scrimmage kick is recovered by K behind the line of scrimmage and K is downed where the recovery is made. The ball belongs to K and the number of the next down is fourth?
- 81 K is awarded a first down if they recover a scrimmage K behind the neutral zone after the kick has been muffed by R in advance of the neutral zone?
- 82 After a distance penalty the ball belongs to the team in possession at the time of the foul?
- 83 Third and 5 for team A from the 50 yard line. A1 runs for a 20 yard gain. A2 is called for a late hit at the 35 yard line. Ruling: First and 10 for team A from the 50 yard line?
- 84 Third and 5 for team A from the 50 yard line. A1 runs for a 20 yard gain. B2 is called for a block in the back at the 35 yard line and A1 is called for an Unsportsmanlike conduct foul. Ruling: What is the results of this play, and when does the clock start?
- a) First and 10 for team A at Team B's 35 yard line?
 - b) Double Foul, replay the down from the previous spot.
 - c) First and 10 for Team A from Team B's 20 yard line?
 - d) First and 10 for Team A from the 30 yard line (where he was tackled).
 - e) The clock starts on the snap.

- f) The clock starts on the ready for play.
- 85 Award a new series to R if K's third down scrimmage kick goes out of bounds behind the neutral zone?
- 86 A free kick is an example of a loose ball play. Thus any penalty that is committed during the down is enforced from the previous spot?
- 87 A free kick that has traveled 10 yards and touched the ground can be recovered and advanced by either team?
- 88 If there is no player in position to catch the free kick it can be caught by the kicking team?
- 89 R1 signals for a fair catch at the 20 yard line. R2 catches the ball at the 25 yard line. Ruling: This is still a fair catch and the ball is dead ?
- 90 Because of a series of penalties K will be free kicking from the R's five yard line. For this free kick R will be required to line up at least five yards in the end zone as free kick lines are always 10 yards apart?
- 91 First touching of a free kick can occur anywhere in the field of play?
- 92 Any legally kicked ball that breaks the plane of R's goal line is a touchback?
- 93 A kick ends as soon as any player secures possession of the ball?
- 94 A runner is the only player that can give an illegal fair catch signal?
- 95 It is illegal for a team to be in scrimmage kick formation and not actually kick the ball?
- 96 For a player to be considered a kicker he must actually legally kick the ball?
- 97 A52 the snapper, has one hand on the ball and the other hand on the ground in advance of the ball. Ruling: This is not encroachment as A52 is the snapper?
- 98 It is an illegal shift if quarterback A1 while calling signals, steps forward and immediately receives the snap?
- 99 It is encroachment for any player to be in the neutral zone once the ready for play signal has been given?
- 100 Pass interference restrictions end for all players when a B team player touches the ball?
- 101 Pass interference restrictions begin for team A players when the pass leaves the quarterbacks hand?
- 102 All roughing the passer penalties and all defensive pass interference penalties carry an automatic first down as a part of the enforcement (if the penalty is accepted)?
- 103 A ball may be handed backwards at any time during the down?
- 104 A12 the quarterback is under a heavy rush and begin to run. As he approaches the neutral zone his front foot is off the ground and in advance of the neutral zone. His back foot is on the ground and behind the zone when he releases a forward pass to A82. Ruling: Legal play?
- 105 A pass by A12 is simultaneously caught by A82 & B45 while both players are in the

air above team B's goal line. A82 comes down in the end zone and B45 comes down on the one yard line with the foremost point of the ball at the one? Ruling : Touchdown

106 A12's forward pass strikes B55 in the helmet behind the neutral zone as he rushes the passer. The ball continues in flight down field where eligible A85 pushes B33 away from the passed ball. Ruling: Pass Interference on A.

107 Possession of a live ball in the opponent's end zone is always a touchdown?

108 All downs are numbered 1-4?

109 A1 breaks through the line of scrimmage and advances to B's 25 yard line where B1 attempts to tackle A1. However, B1 grasps and twist A1's face mask. A1 breaks free and continues on for a touchdown. Ruling: In order to keep the touchdown team A must decline the penalty on B1?

110 Momentum is only a factor for team R and the defense?

111 The try ends when team B gains possession?

112 K1 attempts a long field goal in the final few seconds of a tie game. R2 is positioned in the end zone near the goal. As the kick is coming down R2 jumps up and blocks the kick away. Ruling : Illegal batting penalty on R2.

113 K1 punts from his three yard line. The kick is blocked by R2 and the ball rolls into the end zone where it is recovered and downed by K2. Ruling: Safety

114 Any non-scoring attempt kick that breaks the plane of K's goal line is a touchback?

115 The try ends when it is successful?

116 If a try is to be replayed, team A may select to snap the ball anywhere between the in bound lines?

117 Offensive lineman A77 is using an open hand blocking technique. His hands are facing the opponent but his arms are extended beyond 45 degrees. Ruling: This is a legal blocking technique?

118 All of the following takes place in the free blocking zone and while the ball is still in the zone. Offensive lineman A77 engages defensive lineman B70 with a block below the waist. While still engaged a second offensive lineman A78 comes in and contacts B70 with a block below the knees? Ruling: This is an example of a chop block?

119 In scrimmage kick formation, holder A10 muffs the snap. A10 raises and picks up the ball. A10 immediately returns to the ground where kicker A12 kicks the ball through the uprights and above the crossbar. Ruling: The field goal is good.

120 In scrimmage kick formation, the snap is high and the holder A12 raises to catch the ball. A10 immediately returns to the ground where kicker A12 kicks the ball through the uprights and above the crossbar. Ruling: The field goal is good.

121 On second down and ten from A's own 45 yard line running back A33 is stopped at midfield. A33 is injured on the play and is directed to leave the game. Prior to the next play B5 is guilty of a dead ball encroach foul and a first down is gained by A. On the next play A33 catches a pass for a touchdown. Ruling : Good play and the touchdown is scored?

122 During the third period of the game the coach for team B (the visitors) calls the

referee over to the sideline to inform him that their headsets are no longer operational. The coach of Team "B" then asks the referee to have the home team turn off their headsets as well. Ruling: The referee tells team A they can no longer use the headsets as this gives them an unfair advantage over team B.

- 123 Team A calls a time out and all players come to the side of the field in front of their team box. Five substitutes, four coaches and six team attendants come to the team huddle? Ruling: This is an illegal conference as no more than three attendants can be with the team no matter which type of conference is chosen?
- 124 In a scrimmage formation, kicker K19 is contacted by R12 so that the contact is very hard and K19 falls to the ground? Ruling: Roughing the kicker, a five yard foul and an automatic first down?
- 125 In a scrimmage formation, kicker K19 is contacted by R12 so that the contact is very slight and K19 does not fall to the ground? Ruling: Running into the kicker, a five yard foul and an automatic first down?
- 126 In a scrimmage formation, kicker K19 is contacted by R12 so that the contact is slight but K19 is displaced? Ruling: Running into the kicker, a five yard foul.
- 127 Runner A1 breaks free from midfield. A2 is running between A1 and B1. B1 catches up with A2 and pushes him in the back above the waist. B2 then tackles A1. Ruling: An illegal block in the back by B1.
- 128 Linebacker B51 is lined up in the free blocking zone but is three yards from the line of scrimmage. A55 who is on the line blocks B51 below the waist. Ruling: Legal Block.
- 129 Linebacker B51 is lined up in the free blocking zone but is three yards from the line of scrimmage. A55 who is on the line blocks B51 below the waist from behind. Ruling: Legal Block.
- 130 Linebacker B51 is lined up in the free blocking zone but is three yards from the line of scrimmage. A55 who is on the line blocks B51 from behind but above the waist. Ruling: Legal Block.
- 131 All loose ball penalties are enforced from the basic spot. That is from the previous spot.
- 132 All running play penalties are enforced from the basic spot. That is the end of the run.
- 133 All dead ball penalties are enforced from the basic spot. That is the succeeding spot.
- 134 All penalties that occur simultaneous with the snap are enforced from the basic spot. That is the previous spot.
- 135 To be a PSK penalty the foul has to be on 'R', it must be beyond the neutral zone, the kick must cross the neutral zone and R must be in possession at the end of the down?
- 136 All penalties are 5,10 or 15 yards.
- 137 The penalty for all unsportsmanlike fouls is 15 yards.
- 138 A PASSER IS A PLAYER WHO THROWS A FORWARD OR BACKWARD PASS.
- 139 A RUNNER MAY BE A TEAM A PLAYER WHO IS SIMULATING POSSESSION OF A LIVE BALL.

- 140 K MAY CATCH, TOUCH, MUFF OR BAT A SCRIMMAGE OR FREE KICK IN FLIGHT BEYOND THE NEUTRAL ZONE IF NO PLAYER OF R IS IN POSITION TO CATCH THE BALL.
- 141 K1'S PUNT IS COMING DOWN OVER R'S 15 YARD LINE AND R2 IS IN POSITION TO CATCH THE BALL. K3 CATCHES THE BALL OR OBSTRUCTS R2'S PATH TO THE BALL. THIS IS KICK CATCHING INTERFERENCE AND R MAY TAKE THE RESULTS OF THE PLAY, TAKE AN AWARDED FAIR CATCH AT THE SPOT, HAVE K PENALIZED 15 YARDS FROM THE PREVIOUS SPOT AND REPLAY THE DOWN, OR IN THE CASE OF K'S CATCHING THE KICK, R MAY CHOOSE THE SPOT OF FIRST TOUCHING.
- 142 WHEN CONSIDERING WHETHER A BALL HAS BEEN LEGALLY OR ILLEGALLY HANDED FORWARD, THE POSITION OF THE BALL DETERMINES WHETHER IT IS BEHIND, IN OR BEYOND THE NEUTRAL ZONE. IF THE ENTIRE BALL IS BEYOND THE NEUTRAL ZONE WHEN IT IS RELEASED, IT IS FORWARD HANDING.
- 143 K1 PUNTS FROM THE 50 YARD LINE. THE BALL HITS THE GROUND AT R'S 10 YARD LINE AND ROLLS TOWARD R'S END ZONE. K 2 BATS THE GROUNDED BALL BACKWARD TOWARD K'S GOAL LINE WHEN THE BALL IS ON R'S 1 YARD LINE. THE BALL TOUCHES R2 AT R'S 5 YARD LINE. THE BALL CONTINUES TO ROLL TOWARD K'S GOAL LINE WHEN R4 HOLDS K6 AT R'S 10 YARD LINE TO PREVENT K 6 FROM RECOVERING THE BALL. K9 FALL ON THE BALL AT R'S 12 YARD LINE RULING: K MAY DECLINE THE PENALTY AND RETAIN POSSESSION OF THE BALL AT R'S 12 YARD LINE.
- 144 IN THE FIRST QUARTER, THE HEAD COACH OF TEAM A IS CHARGED WITH A 15 YARD UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT PENALTY. IN THE THIRD QUARTER, AN ASSISTANT COACH RECEIVES A 15 YARD UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT PENALTY. RULING: THE HEAD COACH SHALL BE EJECTED FROM THE STADIUM AREA AS THE 2 ND. FOUL IS ALSO CONSIDERED TO BE ON THE HEAD COACH SINCE HE IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ASSISTANT COACHES CONDUCT.
- 145 FOLLOWING A SAFETY, K'S PUNT HITS THE GROUND AT R'S 30 AND IS BOUNDING TOWARD R'S GOAL LINE. K 2 , IN AN ATTEMPT TO PREVENT THE BALL FROM GOING INTO R'S END ZONE, BATS THE BALL BACKWARD TOWARD K'S GOAL LINE. RULING: LEGAL BAT.
- 146 FOLLOWING A SUCCESSFUL FIELD GOAL, THE REFEREE DISCOVERS THAT A TEE THAT ELEVATES THE BALL MORE THAN TWO INCHES ABOVE THE GROUND WAS USED. RULING: IT IS AN UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT PENALTY ON THE HEAD COACH, HOWEVER, THE FIELD GOAL COUNTS.
- 147 Each team shall provide at least one (1) legal game ball to the Referee at the time the game officials assume authority.
- 148 The muffing or batting of a pass, kick or fumble in flight is not considered a new force.
- 149 Following a fair catch of a scrimmage kick, Team A puts the ball in play by a snap. A1 throws a forward pass intended for A2, but B1 interferes with A2 and the pass falls incomplete. Following administration of the penalty, the captain of A decides to put the ball in play by a free kick. RULING: Legal request and it should be granted.

- 150 Team A kicks a field goal and Team B is guilty of a personal foul during the down. Team A wants to keep the points and have the penalty enforced on the succeeding kickoff. RULING: Legal
- 151 4 th. And 3 for K from their own 10. A scrimmage kick by K1 is muffed beyond the neutral zone by R1 and rebounds back into K's end zone where it is recovered simultaneously by R2 and K3. RULING: Touchdown for R.
- 152 A scrimmage kick comes to rest on R's 6 yard line. R1 attempts to recover and advance, but muffs the ball forcing it into R's end zone, where K recovers and downs the ball. RULING: Touchdown.
- 153 When the trajectory of a scrimmage kick is such that the kick cannot be touched until it comes down, the expanded neutral zone disintegrates immediately.
- 154 4th. And goal from R's 9. Team K sets up for a field goal attempt and Team R immediately substitutes 11 players. R4, in the end zone, thinks that he is the 12 th. Player, withdraws through the end zone across the end line and continues toward his team box. RULING: Dead ball foul for illegal substitution.
- 155 With the ball on A's 30, Team A attempts a legal forward pass. While the pass is in flight, an inadvertent whistle is sounded, after which, the pass falls incomplete. RULING: The down shall be replayed from the previous spot and the clock shall start on the snap.
- 156 Team A takes a charged timeout. During the timeout, all 11 players of A go to the sideline to confer with the coaches. QB, A1 goes off the field and into the team box and uses the headphones to confer with the coaches in the press box. A1 then returns to the field for the remainder of the conferences with the coaches. RULING: Unsportsmanlike conduct penalty, 15 yards.
- 157 Snapper, A1, is positioned over the ball following the ready for play signal, but he has not placed his hand(s) on the ball. A1 has a hand on the ground and then stands erect to call out a blocking assignment. RULING: No foul; the snapper is not restricted as other linemen after placing a hand on or near the ground.
- 158 Prior to the snap, only offensive linemen next to the snapper are permitted to lock legs with the snapper. However, following the snap, the offensive linemen may interlock feet.
- 159 If a non-player hinders an opponent(player) outside the field of play, it constitutes illegal participation.
- 160 A loose ball play includes the run or runs which precedes the loose ball. There can be only one loose ball play during a down.
- 161 A player cannot commit a penalty.
- 162 K's ball, 4 th and 10 from R's 30 yard line. K1's punt lands untouched five yards beyond the line then rolls backwards behind the neutral zone to R's 35, where the kick is batted toward Team K's goal line by K5. RULING: Legal Bat.
- 163 A's ball, 3 rd. and 18 from its own 3 yard line. A1's pass from his own end zone is intercepted by B2 at A's 27 yard line. Before the pass was thrown, A7 is flagged for holding in A's end zone. B2 returns the interception for a touchdown.

RULING: B may keep the touchdown and have the penalty for A7's hold enforced on the try.

- 164 When measuring for a possible first down, if the ball becomes dead in a side zone, the ball should be placed at the inbounds spot before a measurement is made.
- 165 The back judge's position for a scrimmage kick (non field goal or try) is slightly deeper than the deepest receiver, on the Linesman's side of the field.
- 166 The linesman and line judge will use extended arms, at 90 degree angles, held until the referee and umpire acknowledge the signals, to indicate the two (2) widest Team A players who are on or off the line of scrimmage.
- 167 On 2 nd and 12 from A's 2 yard line. QB, A1 is tackled in A's end zone for a safety. During the play, lineman, A6 is flagged for a personal foul. RULING: Team B may keep the two points for the safety and have the penalty for A6's personal foul administered from the succeeding spot.
- 168 At the snap flanker, A8 streaks downfield on a pass route. Defensive back, B2 sees that he will not be able to break up the pass, which is thrown toward A8, so B2 tackles A8 to prevent A8 from catching the pass and scoring a certain touchdown. The pass falls incomplete as the BJ flags B2 for pass interference. RULING: Intentional Pass Interference by B2. The penalty for pass interference is 15 yards from the previous spot plus and automatic first down. Also, Team B should be penalized and additional 15 yards for the intentional pass interference, this is an unsportsmanlike act.
- 169 Wind Directional streamers atop the uprights may be orange, red or white.
- 170 Defensive lineman, B7 intercepts A1's legal forward pass in B's end zone and then passes backward to B2 who bats the ball so that it goes out of bounds across the end line. RULING: If the penalty is accepted for B2' s foul, the result is a safety. The spot of enforcement for B2's bat is the end zone, resulting in a safety.
